

Leadership Edmond Application - 2010 - 2011

MISSION

Leadership Edmond is a leadership development program designed to provide community leaders with a deeper understanding of the critical issues affecting the Edmond area. This program also provides an ongoing source of diverse leaders who are prepared and committed to serve as catalysts and sustainers of positive change for the quality of life in the Edmond area.

The program begins with a two-day out of town retreat in August which focuses on community leadership skills and team building. The remaining eight, one-day long sessions meet once a month and each focus on a specific community topic such as city government, education, health/wellness, state government and volunteerism.

Class size is limited to 35 individuals. Class members are selected to represent a broad range of occupations and backgrounds.

Participants receive in-depth exposure to the critical issues facing the community through lectures, discussion groups, on-site visits, simulations and other leadership development activities. Participants also get a chance to meet key community leaders. The location and format of each session is different. The program enables participants to develop their leadership capacities, build strong relationships and prepare themselves for the challenges of years to come. The 2010-2011 class will be the 26th class of Leadership Edmond.

COMMITMENT

The course consists of a **mandatory two-day out of town opening retreat**, eight one-day sessions and a graduation. As with all worthwhile endeavors, this program requires a definite commitment of time on the part of each participant. ***If you are unable to attend the opening retreat, please do not apply.***

Attendance is mandatory for successful completion of the program. Absence from more than one full session (or the accumulation of partial sessions that equals one full session) will make the participant ineligible to graduate. Outside reading and meetings along with one City Council and one School Board meeting are also required. You will have the optional opportunity to serve on a local nonprofit board of directors during the year!

- **Must be received in the Edmond Chamber office no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 23, 2009. Application must be in by 5 p.m. on July 9, 2009 for the early-bird special.**

TUITION

Each applicant accepted for the program is required to make a tuition payment of \$700. If you are an early - bird applicant (July 9, 2010 at 5 p.m. is the deadline) you may submit your tuition of \$650 with the application. Tuition includes class materials, meals, overnight lodging at opening retreat and name tag. Payment can be made by personal check, corporate check, or major credit card and must be received by August 6, 2010, in order to secure participants spot in the class. If payment is not received by August 6, 2010 the open spot will go to an alternate applicant. Tuition is non-refundable.
